

The relation BD has with the world of art goes right back to it's origins. It began with the helping hand of one of the best artists from the 20th century, Salvador Dalí. Between 1972 and 1974 we developed the Salivasofá with the Master (the famous sofa inspired by Mae West's lips), the initial venture by BD of limited editions. Although it never reached production, it was the declaration of intentions. BD continued in 1975 to produce furniture that Antoni Gaudí designed for his Batlló and Calvet houses, following exactly the same production processes that were implimented with the first pieces.

The launching of the collection of the furniture and lamps by Salvador Dalí in 1991 marked a milestone. For the first time, objects designed by Dalí were made for functional use (unlike the sculptures) and other furniture was extracted from the artist's paintings.

This catalogue gathers all of the objects in our collection which are closer to art than design. All of the pieces presented here are manufactured by artisans, are limited editions or are produced in small numbered quantities. Recent additions that measure up to the afore mentioned authors are Fernando and Humberto Campana, Jaime Hayon, Ettore Sottsass and Doshi Levien.


La relación de BD con el mundo del arte se remonta a sus orígenes. Comenzó de la mano de uno de los mayores artistas del S.XX, Salvador Dalí. Entre 1972 y 1974 desarrollamos con el maestro el Salivasofá (el famoso sofá inspirado en los labios de Mae West), la primera incursión de BD en las series limitadas, que aunque nunca llegó a producirse, era ya toda una declaración de intenciones. Seguiría en 1975 con la producción de los muebles que Antoni Gaudí diseñó para sus casas Batlló y Calvet, siguiendo exactamente los mismos procesos de producción que se emplearon en su momento para producir las primeras piezas.

El lanzamiento de la colección de muebles y lámparas de Salvador Dalí en 1991 marcó todo un hito. Por primera vez se producían objetos diseñados por Dalí para ser usados con una función (a diferencia de las esculturas) y se desarrollaban muebles extraídos de cuadros del artista.

Este catálogo recoge todos los objetos de nuestra colección que están más cerca del arte que del diseño. Todos los objetos aquí presentados se fabrican de forma artesanal y en series limitadas o producciones numeradas muy pequeñas. A los autores antes mencionados se han unido recientemente nombres de la talla de Fernando y Humberto Campana, Jaime Hayon, Ettore Sottsass o Doshi Levien.




















